MFC Singles – World Singles Congress 2025

More than **800 MFC Singles, Couple Coordinators, and Servants** from around the world gathered at the **Baguio Convention and Cultural Center** last **March 21–23** for the **World Singles Congress 2025**, with the theme “*Always Hope*” (Romans 12:12).

The three-day event was filled with prayer, worship, fellowship, and powerful sessions that reminded participants to rejoice in hope, persevere in prayer, and endure in affliction. Highlights included the *Hope Trails* reflective activity, inspiring talks from EWTN and LCSC, the *Restoration Tower* healing experience, and joyful community moments like the *Summer Sundown* fellowship night.

The congress concluded with participants boldly declaring their hope in Jesus during the *Bearers of Hope* activity, leaving them renewed, empowered, and ready to carry hope into their families, workplaces, and communities.



MFC Handmaids – World Handmaids Congress 2025

With hearts ablaze and spirits lifted high, nearly **1,200 women** gathered for the **World Handmaids Congress 2025** on **May 24–25** at the **Sison Auditorium** in **Lingayen, Pangasinan**, celebrating the powerful theme: **LUMINA – Women of Hope**.

The event was graced by the inspiring presence of **Archbishop Soc Villegas** and **Bishop Fidelis Layug**, who presided over the Holy Masses. The congress overflowed with prayer, worship, and soul-stirring messages rooted in Romans 12:12: *“Rejoice in hope, endure in affliction, persevere in prayer.”*

MFC Servants – World Servants Congress 2025

Hope abounds for the Men of Hope—Mga ASTiG ng Pag-aso! The **World Servants Congress 2025** was held last **March 15–16** at **St. James Retreat House, Tagaytay**, with the theme “*Men of Hope*” based on Romans 12:12: “*Rejoice in hope, endure in affliction, persevere in prayer.*”

The congress opened with the celebration of the Holy Mass and the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, setting a sacred tone for the weekend. Three powerful sessions followed, each anchored in the theme verse. In the first session, **Fr. Edwin Soliva** spoke on *Persevere in Prayer*, encouraging the men to deepen their relationship with God through constant, committed prayer. Fulltime Worker Sharing

I am Azenette Samson from the area of Tacloban, a full-time missionary assigned in Visayas. I entered the community through a Youth Camp eight years ago. My life has never been the same since then. It is in this community where I have discovered the skills and talents that I have been blessed with. Ultimately, it is through this community where I had the opportunity to grow deeper in faith through service and prayer.

It was in my first mission outside of our area in the summer of 2019 where I first encountered the desire to be a full-time missionary, but it was the same year when I entered college. Fast forward to October 2022, I was again on a mission when I felt God calling me to give myself for Him as a missionary. This time, I was already in my last year in college. The thought of it never left my mind, and so I started sincerely praying about it. A few months passed, and the desire grew deeper.



As I asked God to purify my desire, my weaknesses were exposed. I was already in my last semester in college when I was diagnosed with major depressive disorder. I underwent medication and monthly visits to a psychiatrist. There were so many questions and prayers that came up, but the calling did not change. Even after being diagnosed, God led me to more missions. The desire to be a full-time missionary became clearer.



The healing journey took a year. I was healed and I graduated with a Bachelor in Arts in Psychology in University of the Philippines Tacloban. I took the board and became a licensed psychometrician. After going through the highs and lows of sickness, God's desire for me to be a full-time missionary was fulfilled last July 2024. The journey was long, unpredictable, and painful. But everything that happened was necessary to help prepare me for the joy that lies ahead. True enough, the joy that I am experiencing now is incomparable to the sufferings that I have experienced. I am now confident that even when trials and sorrows come, God can still turn it into an experience of hope. If God wills it, then so be it. For the joy of Heaven is far greater than the sufferings.

I am only able to respond to the call because I have experienced the immeasurable love of God. I want to share that love to others by being a missionary. I may experience sickness, sufferings, and loneliness away from home and family, but all is worth it as I look forward to a life of complete joy and fulfillment for all of us in Heaven, our True Home.

All for God, who brought hope to my life, I lay down everything as a missionary.
